That's what the September edition of Whistleblower magazine – titled "POWER PLAY" – is all about.

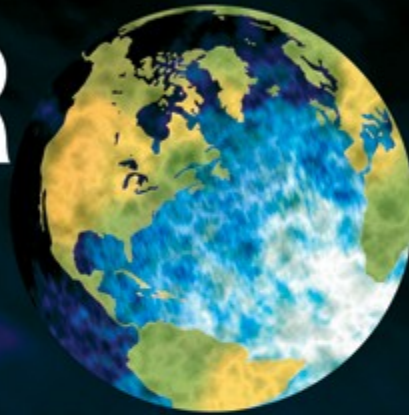

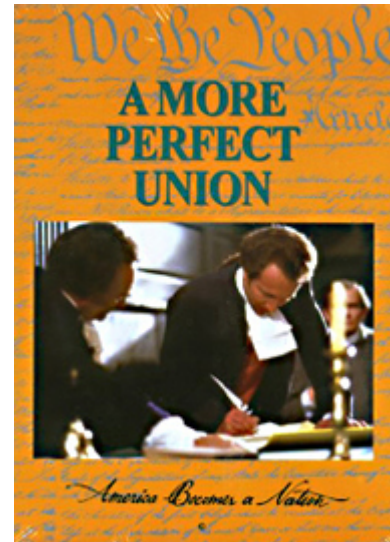

He warns: "In terms of the 2010 election, cap-and-trade is a litmus test for Congress members' sanity: You can't be a sane, responsible, honest representative and support this

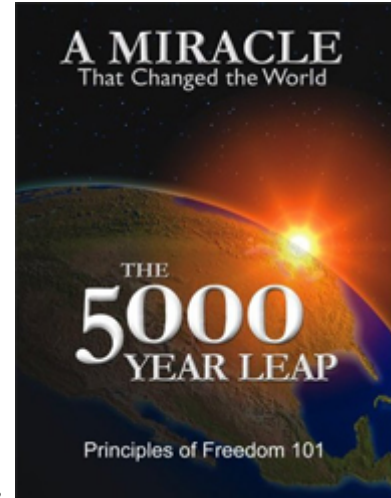
legislation. It's crucial that Americans understand what this is really all about – an all-out assault on America – and let their congressmen know before it's too late."
